West Sussex Saxophones – gather round Bignor Park's mini temple where a young quartet of saxophone players will be showing off their skills

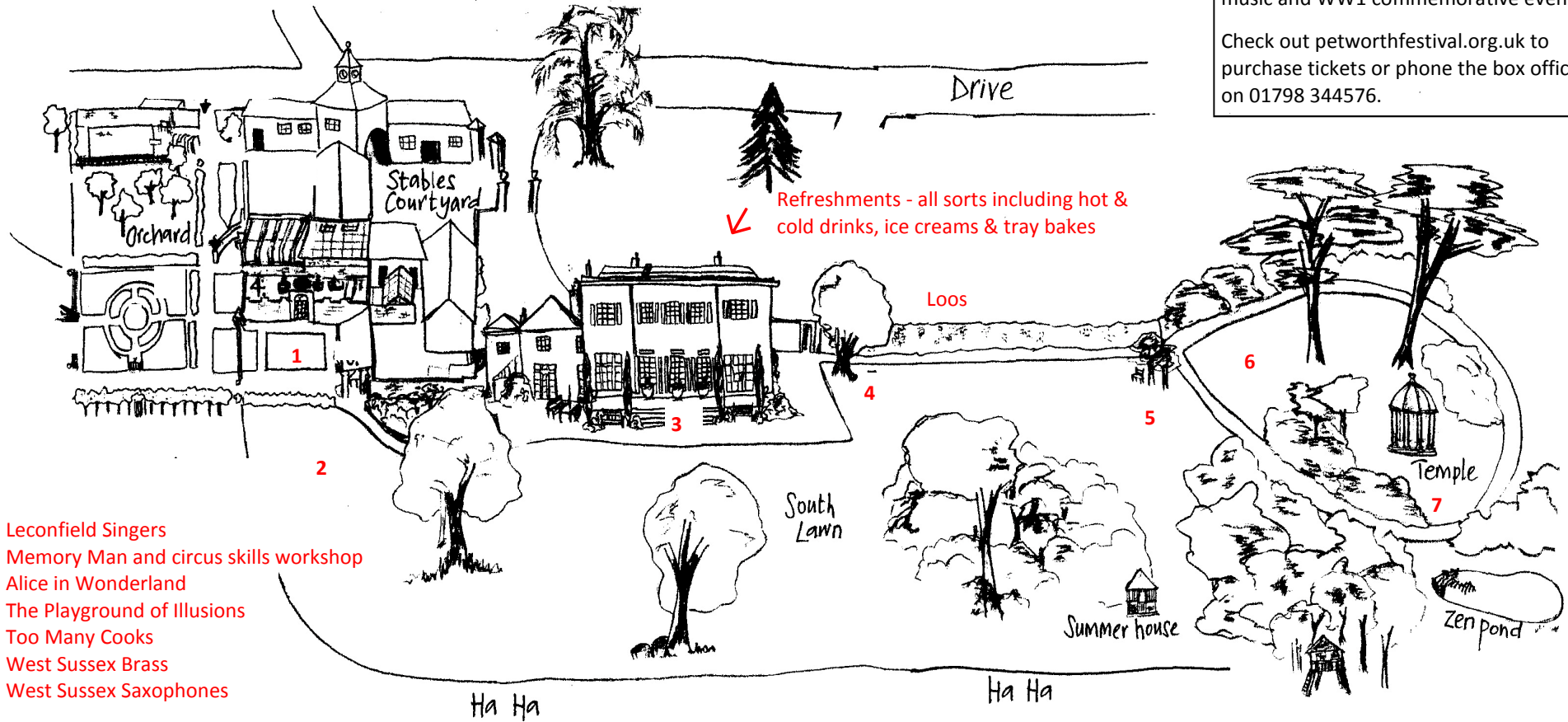


Bignor Park Garden
